Dear Vaughn Road/S. Cranbrook Road Resident:

On Tuesday, September 23, 2014, the City of Bloomfield Hills held a resident meeting to provide information concerning the project, review preliminary plans, and to answer individual questions. During the resident information meeting, a tentative project schedule and traffic map during construction flyer was distributed. Enclosed is a copy of the handout for your reference.

Vaughn Road will be under construction first. After Vaughn Road is opened to traffic, the contractor will then start construction on South Cranbrook likely near the 4th of July holiday. This tentative project schedule is dependent on the winter weather, frost laws, and the contractor's proposed schedule. If you have any events planned at your residence during construction on your road, please let us know as soon as possible to allow us work with you and the contractor.

To maintain traffic during construction, one lane of traffic will be closed and the other lane will be a one way road. Northbound traffic will be maintained on both Vaughn Road and South Cranbrook. You will not be able to go southbound on either one of the roads during construction. There will be lane shifts occurring during the construction to the left or right side of the road but you will always be able to travel northbound.

This presentation has information about the project itself: water main construction, reconstruction of the road, proposed roadway width, and pictures of before and after of similar project.
